

Country Brief on Global Fund Investments and Impact In the Republic of Rwanda



The Republic of Rwanda is both a donor and implementor for Global Fund-supported programs since 2003 during which significant progress has been made towards ending HIV, TB and Malaria

Overview

- Between 2010 and 2020, the number of AIDS-related deaths decreased by 59%, from approximately 5,900 in 2010 to approximately 2,500 in 2020.
- The proportion of people living with HIV receiving antiretroviral drugs more than doubled, from 89,000 in 2010 to 207,000 in 2020.
- During the last long-lasting insecticidal net campaign in 2019 and 2020, Rwanda successfully distributed 5.57 million nets. In 12 districts targeted for indoor residual spraying, 99% of the population was covered.
- Between 2010 and 2020, coverage of medication that prevents mother-to-child transmission of HIV increased from 59% to 98%. TB mortality declined by 40% between 2012 and 2020.
- Between 2020 and 2021, the number of malaria cases decreased by 41%.

7th Global Fund Replenishment at a Glance

20 years of Global Fund Partnership has saved 44 Million lives and this year the seventh replenishment will be the largest so far, with ambitious targets of getting back on track to end the epidemics while strengthening health systems to deal with future pandemics.

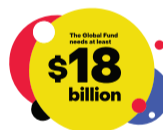
