

Country Brief on Global Fund Investments and Impact In the Republic of Kenya



The Republic of Kenya is both a donor and implementor for Global Fund-supported programs since 2003 during which significant progress has been made towards ending HIV, TB and Malaria

Overview

- The number of people living with HIV receiving antiretroviral treatment increased from 31% in 2010 to 86% in 2020.
- Coverage of medication that prevents mother to-child transmission of HIV increased from 55% in 2010 to 94% in 2020.
- TB treatment coverage increased from 45% in 2010 to 60% in 2019.
- Strong collaboration between TB and HIV service delivery has resulted in nearly universal screening and treatment of TB/HIV co-infected patients.
- In 2020, 98% of TB patients knew their HIV status and 97% of TB patients that tested positive for HIV were on antiretroviral therapy during TB treatment.
- Kenya has successfully implemented three long-lasting insecticidal net campaigns since 2014, with more than 42 million mosquito nets distributed to protect people from malaria.

7th Global Fund Replenishment at a Glance

20 years of Global Fund Partnership has saved 44 Million lives and this year the seventh replenishment will be the largest so far, with ambitious targets of getting back on track to end the epidemics while strengthening health systems to deal with future pandemics.

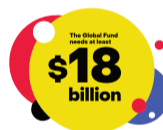
