



## Heartfelt “Thank you” for your Pledges to Gavi

**Dear Excellencies, Distinguished Donor Partners, Philanthropies, Private sector and Governments,**

From clinics and community halls to schools and mobile outreach sites across our continent, we, communities and African civil society networks, extend our deepest appreciation for your leadership at the **Global Summit: Health & Prosperity through Immunisation in Brussels**. Your pledges have propelled Gavi's replenishment past US\$9 billion towards the US\$11.9 billion goal for 2026–2030, a lifeline that will help protect 500 million children and avert 8–9 million future deaths, while strengthening primary health care and outbreak preparedness.

We are equally encouraged by the broader package announced at the Summit: US\$4.5 billion in complementary financing from development finance institutions to reinforce country systems; up to US\$200 million in cost savings offered by manufacturers; and more than US\$149 million in private-sector partnerships to supercharge immunisation delivery.

This is what true global solidarity looks like turning resources into real protections for people. As African civil society organisations (CSOs) and community networks, we witness the impact of your solidarity every day: stocked vaccine fridges; reliable cold chains; community health workers with fuel for motorbikes; and parents reassured that their children are protected. Your pledges mean fewer zero-dose and under-immunised children, stronger local manufacturing and supply resilience, and faster, fairer access to high-impact vaccines.

Looking ahead, we stand ready to collaborate with governments, Gavi, and country stakeholders to translate every pledge into equitable coverage, especially for zero-dose children while strengthening accountability, community demand, and last-mile delivery. Please accept our profound gratitude and our continued partnership to ensure every child, all people, everywhere, receive lifesaving vaccines.
